 - Formation Skydiving,
 - Canopy Formation,
 - Artistic Events,
 - Canopy Piloting,
 - Wingsuit Flying.
- No Judging Seminar was held in 2022 nor were there any in person judging committee meetings.
- Judges participated in 5 competitions remotely using InTime Cloud gaining valuable experience with this technology.
- Overall, in 2022 eight judges participated in 16 different competitions held both in Canada and international.
